Hello HSC Residents and Families,

I have some good news to share with you this week. We have received all of our Health Service Center staff and Resident COVID-19 test results from this past Monday and they were all negative. We did have one staff member within the HHH community test positive, however they have had no direct contact with any of our residents or staff. Currently, we do not have any floors on precautions!! We will be testing all the staff and residents again this coming Monday, 1/25.

This coming Wednesday, 1/27 and Thursday 1/28 we will have a second COVID-19 vaccine clinic. As a reminder, we do need a new consent form for the second vaccine. If you are the activated Durable Power of Attorney for Healthcare for your loved one, please return the signed consent form to us by Monday 1/25. Thank you to those who have already returned them.

The COVID-19 positivity rate in Merrimack County remains at a high level of community transmission, so we are still unable to hold indoor visits at this time.

Next week we are planning a “Where’s Waldo” week with residents and staff, which we are hoping will be a fun activity for all! The Programs and Pastoral Care staff are also continuing to run small group activities (bingo, mediation, sing along, armchair exercises, etc.).
