Dear HSC Residents and Families,

I wanted to update you all that we received results from this week's surveillance testing. We had one HSC staff member test positive for COVID-19. This person had no prolonged exposure to residents. All other results have returned and all were negative.

After consulting with the state, it has been determined that there is no additional quarantine required, and it will not impact visitation at this time. Compassionate, Essential and Social Visits will continue using the current process. This change from needing an additional quarantine, as was needed in the past, is due to all residents having been vaccinated. We will participate in response testing, which means that all residents and staff will be tested for COVID-19 for the next two weeks, on Monday 5/3 and Monday 5/10.

The CDC has come out with new information this week, updating their current recommendations for COVID-19. We are currently waiting for guidance from the State of New Hampshire, with their interpretation of this information and if it will impact our current guidelines regarding re-opening. I will continue to update you with any changes.
