Dear HSC Residents and Families,

The FDA (Food and Drug Administration) has given their approval for the Pfizer vaccine as of today. We anticipate this leading to some guidance for booster shots for residents and staff. As we find out any information we will share this with all of you.

Cases of COVID-19 are on the rise in our Community. We continue to ask and remind all staff and visitors to always wear face masks, eye protection and wash your hands frequently. A couple of questions that have come up with the reimplantation of face shields:

- 1.) Do we provide face shields? Yes, we do. We ask that you keep the same face shield for 5 days and wash the shield in between visits. These can be cleaned with any form of disinfecting wipe.
- 2.) Can I wear eye goggles instead of a face shield? A visitor can wear their own goggles or safety eye wear as an alternative to a face shield. We also ask that you clean the goggles between visits.

In other news, our Raine Unit-Assisted Living, had their annual state survey last week. The survey was deficiency free! Congratulations to our team!!
